Explore your employment and training options. If you have a permanent cognitive impairment or intellectual disability and need support with your learning and goal setting for future employment, then our Certificate I in Work Education could be the course for you.

About the course

The focus of this course is to enable students with special learning needs to gain independence and community awareness. Students will gain an understanding of other courses and improve their employment skills.

The Certificate I in Work Education will provide students with a range of practical experience. It will give students an understanding of basic workplace expectations and prepare them to enter the workforce.

Elective units in our courses may be amended for specific organisational needs. Consultation with the Education and Training Manager is required for tailored electives that align with your organisations requirements.

Course duration

This model is delivered over a 50 week period.

Classroom model - Training is delivered 2 days a week (excluding public holidays and school holidays).

Entry requirements

There are no formal education entry requirements for this course. However, to enrol you must be willing to obtain a:

- Working with Children's Check
- National Police Check
- · NDIS Worker Screening Check (if required).

You will also need to provide evidence of COVID-19 vaccination.

Practical placement

Students will participate in 2 to 6 vocational activities.

*You will need to undergo a National Police Check before you begin the practical placement. Practical placement may not be possible if a check that is carried out contains adverse outcomes. In this instance, you may not be able to complete your qualification and your employment opportunities may be affected. If you are aware of, or are concerned about anything that may appear on a Police Check, please discuss this at your enrolment interview.

Course fees

Government funded: \$100

*Enrolment Fee includes the administration and materials cost.

Self-funded: \$16,240

Individuals ineligible for funding are obligated to cover the self-funded fee, which incorporates the enrolment fee. Eligibility criteria applies.

For additional service fees, such as re-assessment fees or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), please refer to the Student Course Guide. This program is delivered with Victorian and Commonwealth Government funding to eligible candidates.
